

Recital Tips For Parents and Guardians
Ask Questions Early
It might be hard to contact staff on the day of the recital. Please ask questions in advance.
Investigate the commute.
Look into how far the venue is from your home or from wherever you will be coming form. See Page 1
Buy shoes, tights undergarments in advance.
Buy shoes, tights, and anything else needed at least 30 days in advance. By doing this, you can avoid
needing an item that's sold out, that won't arrive on time, or doesn't fit. When new shoes are needed,
it's very helpful for dancers to practice in them before the big day!
Label all items with your dancer's name.
We want everyone to go home with the correct shoes, skirts, bags, cups, lovies, etc Personal items
can easily get confused. Masking tape is great for labeling items. Labeling alleviates your stress when
you come to pick up your child. (See Page 7 for examples)
Assure that your dancer arrives on time.
Please aim to have your dancer back stage by arrival time. This helps calm the dancers down and
allows the recital to begin on time.
Don't Stress
 Everyone's hair and make-up will look slightly different and that's ok!
• Perfectionism is not the goal. We want this to be a fun and special experience for both you and your
dancer.
 All the tips listed above should help you not stress.
Consider Bringing Flowers
Many dancers will get flowers. Some dancers get upset if they see peers getting flowers and not them.
Enjoy the show!
Recital day is special for children and parents. Like I said before, "don't stress" enjoy it!



Recital Tips For Audience Members

Attend the whole recital.

Audience members should plan to attend the entire recital even if their loved one performs early or late in the recital.

Note: Audience members do not have to attend all 4 recitals.

Remain Seated During Dance Numbers

Movement in the audience is distracting for dancers and to other audience members. It's best to try to remain seated when dancers are on stage.

Consider sitting in the back of the auditorium if you attend with a small child.

Young children may lose interest, need to use the bathroom, get noisy, etc..... By sitting in the back, you are more likely to leave the auditorium with minimal attention on you or the child.

Enter and Exit the Auditorium between dances.

- If you need to leave or enter the auditorium during a recital for any reason, please wait for a transition between dances.
- When outside the auditorium, you will hear applause whenever a dance is finished which is a good time to enter.

Silence Your Cell Phones

Just like in a movie theater, cell phones should be silenced, and alarms should be off.

Watch Quietly

It is important to refrain from talking during recitals. Even if the dancers are too far away to hear you, whispers can be distracting to other audience members.

What is Dress Rehearsal Week

What is Dress Rehearsal Week???

A week (Monday - Friday) when all dancers wear their dance recital costumes to their dance classes. During this week. dancers practice their recital dance and the teacher takes pictures.

When is dress rehearsal week Each Year?

Dress Rehearsal Week consists of the weekdays leading up to the recitals. (Monday - Friday & then the recitals are during the weekend.)

What time is it?

During your child's regularly scheduled dance class(es). (EX: The Monday 2–4-year-old Tumble class meets each Monday from 5:15-5:45pm so they will have their dress rehearsal on Monday, May 13th from 5:00-5:30 pm).

Where is it?

At Goins Dancing!

Does my Child need to have her Hair and Make up done during Dress Rehearsal week?

Hair and make-up is not required. Parents are welcome to do their child's hair and make if they would like. Some parents choose to practice hair and make-up for the teacher to see it (either during this week... or week earlier in the dance season).

Should my child wear regular Clothes and then change into a costume?

We do not have a lot of space for dancers to change. Please have you dancers arrive and leave in their costumes. If you need to have your dancer change either upon arrival or prior to leaving, please let their teacher know.

What about Competition Costumes?

Dancers will not wear their competition costumes during Dress Rehearsal Week because they have already performed in them.

When is Recital Week 2024?

May 13th - May 17th
